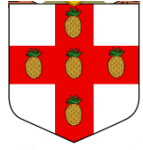




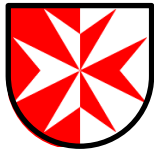

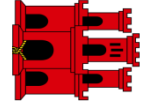

**The Coats of Arms of
British Dominions and
Colonies During WWI**

The spectacular stained glass lead light ceiling directly above the entrance foyer shows the Coat of Arms of all British Dominions and Colonies during the First World War.

From the north east corner clockwise they are:

(East wall) Gibraltar, Kenya, South Africa, and New Foundland

(South wall) Canada, Great Britain, New Zealand and Australia

(West wall) India, Ceylon, Malaya, and the Straits Settlements

(North wall) Channel Islands, Fiji, Jamaica and Malta.

Underneath the skylight are golden badges of the units, regiments and corps in which men and women from the Auckland Province served. British badges acknowledge those who joined British units.

On the wall opposite the altar is a world map showing the principal engagements of the war.

At the foot and the top of the maps are rows of Coats of Arms of British dominions and colonies, and of the allied nations.
